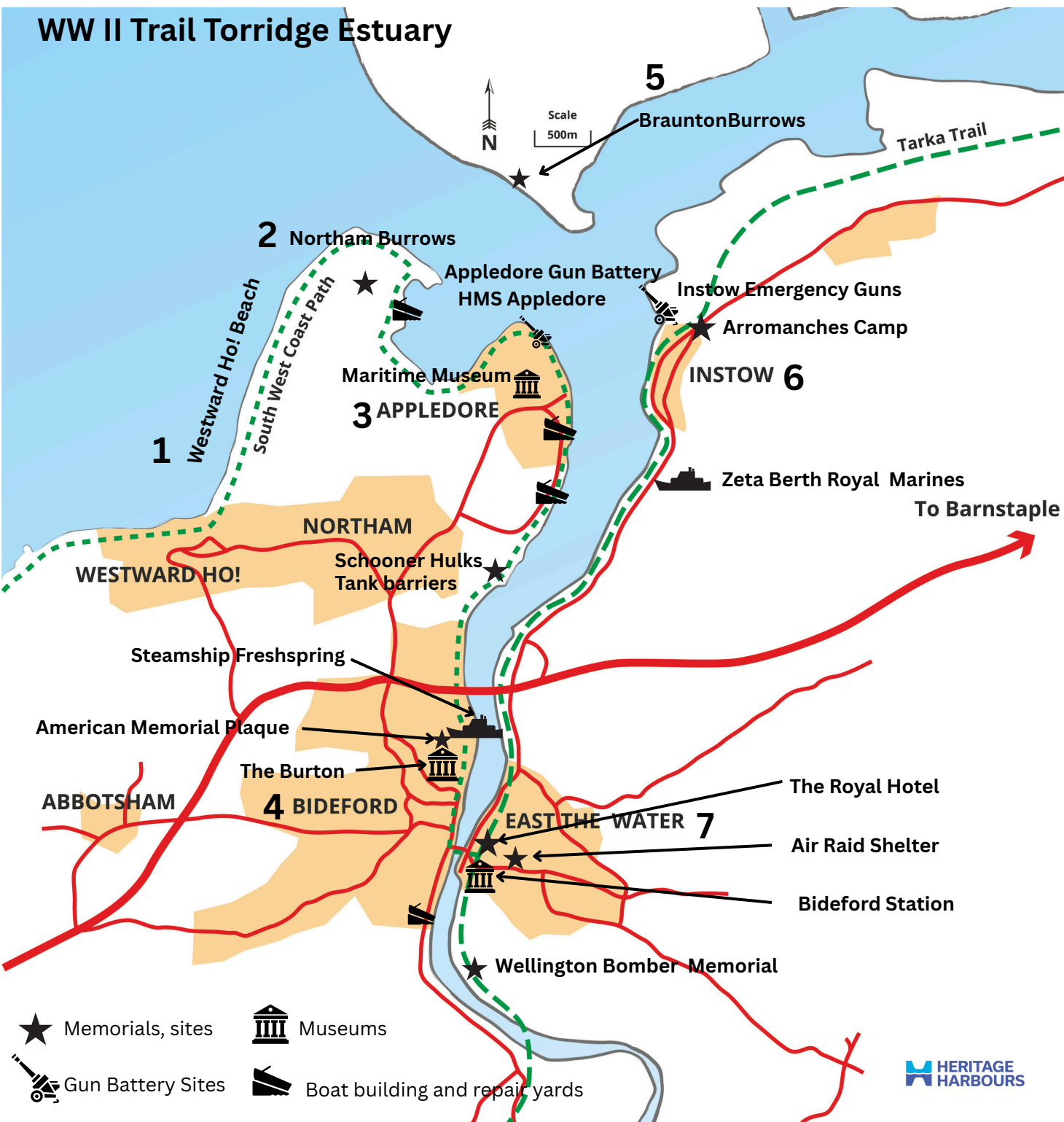

During 1940, when invasion was imminent, barriers against landing craft and troops were erected and Home Guard units had hidden bases to operate from in case of invasion.

As the tide of war changed the area played a major role in preparing for the invasion of Normandy.

Experimental stations worked out how to waterproof vehicles, essential for a successful seaborne landing.

The American Army set up huge camps and training areas. Beaches became training grounds for the invasion of Europe in June 1944.

Amongst the first men ashore on D-Day were the 'frogmen', trained at Appledore in explosives and beach clearing.

After the war much was cleared away but there are still traces if you know where to look . . .
